Andres Correa Jr., age 73, of Miami, FL, passed away peacefully on Sunday December 8th, 2024. Born in San Juan, Puerto Rico to Luz Maria Baez and Andres Correa Sr., Andres was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, uncle, brother, and friend.
