“ Dale and I worked at the same Firm in Florida. He once told me a stories of his trip to Franklin, Tennessee (20 miles south of Nashville); intensely interesting to me because I once lived there. He described places I knew well and town entirely changed beyond recognition.

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Or maybe related things that were going on in his life, as how he got some nice hurricane proof windows installed in his house. Or that his wife lost her job and how they had to cut back on eating out. He conveyed being pleased with his marriage, been together a ton of years and still was going strong, looking forward to a ton more. On the side, he had a vitamin business going on and gave me a bag of samples to try. I'm still making my way through them.

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One of our ongoing conversations regarded some angle He was working to get his Macintosh notebook computer fixed because it developed some kind of screen problem. If I remember correctly, the video image was not filling the screen but only a portion of it. The discussion about this gone on for some weeks as we tried to figure out what might the problem be and how to solve it.

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However someone solved it for him His home was burglarized. Such an intrusion is an outrage for anyone who experienced it, as among other things burglary of one's home is a grievous loss of privacy. Swiped was the computer with its screen problems. This compelled Dale to get a replacement Mac. Got it from a place <http://resale.headgap.com/>. He seemed pleased with his replacement computer.

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Dale had a physical handicap which promoted him to use a rollator, a walker with wheels. It was kind of nice, as it had a seat which lifted up like a lid to reveal a storage compartment underneath. People asked him about it, where to get one for their aging parents or relatives.

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I was transferred to another department and lost touch with Dale. I would still see him now and then. He started coming to work in a wheelchair then not at all. I did not think too hard about that, maybe he was on vacation. After a few weeks of this I asked around, "Dale where is he? I haven't seen him around."

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Turned out Dale retired. Earlier conversations with him touched on the subject but retirement still seemed a ways off. "Good," I thought, he will now be able to enjoy time with this wife and family, those windows he put in, and really work with his computer. Two weeks or so later, I heard the sad news. Dale was gone. Much of his waking life was spent here at the Firm. So little of it was spent in his retirement, He did not get a chance to do all the stuff he planned. Or maybe working at the Firm gave him something he really needed. I don't know. I'm trying to work out if there is a lesson in there somewhere.

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Dale is where he does not need Rollator or Wheelchair, a promised gift if accepted that can be looked forward to :
