Louis Vincent D'Agnese, age 91, passed away January 7, 2015 in Pembroke Pines, Florida. After coming to this country at the age of six, Louis worked diligently in school and became a member of the Benjamin Franklin Honor Society. After high school, he was a member of the United States Army stationed in England during World War II. He joined the New York City Department of Corrections, worked his way up to the rank of Captain and finally retired as Assistant Deputy Warden.
