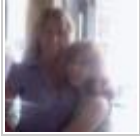

Renea was gifted in school. She was funny and silly always, kind and generous with her time, energy and things, and a determined powerhouse as a human. She worked hard in high school, and at her job at Gianni's Pizza in Monterey, CA. From that job, she earned enough money to purchase a car for herself, a blue Renault. She joined the Air Force after high school so she would have an easier time educating herself and getting her braces. Throughout her adult life she found grants, awards and programs to apply for to get the support she needed for what she wanted to pursue. She was a "go getter!" She came out of her station in New Mexico with a Bachelor in Nursing and specialized as a registered nurse in telemetry, after being enlisted for 4 years in the Air Force and continuing 4 years with the Air Force Reserves. She worked for many years as a traveling nurse to help people and travel while doing it. That job took her to San Francisco, Hawaii, Sacramento and Florida. Renea was very caring and kind. Her two children, Sydney and Anthony who reside with their father, carry much of her within themselves. Sydney has inherited her high intelligence and Anthony has inherited her huge heart. Renea fought endlessly, tirelessly for her rights as a mother to be in her children's life. She took law courses and represented herself in court extremely well, but the mental health stigma that was upon her, unfortunately and unfairly lost her case every time. Renea was stimulating, pleasant and intelligent to have a conversation with. She appreciated quality time and she was so very thoughtful. She trusted me to take care of her and her final arrangements in her last few months and I am still honored, and always will be. Renea lives on in my heart, daily in my mind and she is one of the souls I hope to live forever with after I finish my time here in this world.*

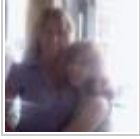
